He completed a Post Graduate Diploma in Photography at the Michaelis School of Fine Art in 2017 after completing a B.A at AFDA Film School. He has been represented by THK Gallery since September 2019.

THK gallery presented a selection of his works at the Also Known As Africa (AKAA) Art Fair from 9-11 November 2019, as well as at the Cologne Fine Art & Design Fair from 21-24 November 2019. His work was exhibited in a duo show at THK Gallery over the period of the Investec Cape Town Art Fair 2020, followed by a group show in late 2020 and a solo online presentation in 2021. THK Gallery will be participating in Paris Photo 2021, the world's largest international art fair dedicated to photography. The gallery will present a solo exhibition by Johno Mellish in the fair's Curiosa sector, which showcases new talent to leading collectors, curators, and art aficionados from around the world.
